Old Business:

1. Consider and approve minutes from previous meeting.
Bryan Stringer made a motion to approve minutes from last meeting. Motion Passed.

New Business:

1. **Consider and discuss Arbor Day 2022.**
Arbor Day activities will be on April 12th, 9 am and 1 pm at Fairview Elementary School. Mayor Rife will be asked to read the proclamation at the 9 am ceremony. Brian Bradley will provide supplies for the event. Jon Skinner and Tree Board Members who can attend will be present to plant the tree at each ceremony.
2. **Consider and discuss other events for 2022.**

Other Business:

2. The Tree Board has received a request to recommend tree plantings in parking lot beautification projects the city is taking on.

Bryan Stringer made a motion to recommend that John Pair Caddo Sugar Maple trees be planted. Motion passed unanimously.
