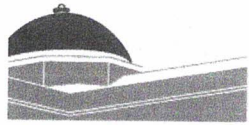

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The Carthage Public Library Board of Trustees met Tuesday, October 11, 2022, in the Carthage Public Library, Steadley Family Legacy Center. The meeting was called to order at 5:14 pm by Sandy Swingle, Vice-President.

Roll Call

Board Members present: Sandy Swingle, Julie Anderson, Nancy Dymott, Donna Thomason, Brian Schmidt and Kevin Johnson. Board Members absent: Gary Cole, Justin Baucom and Carrie Campbell. Library Director Julie Yockey was also present as was Brandi Ensor, City Council representative.

Minutes of Last Meeting

There were no changes to the minutes of the last regular meeting of August 9, 2022. A motion to approve the regular meeting minutes was made by Brian Schmidt and seconded by Julie Anderson. Motion passed unanimously. A meeting was not held in September 2022.

Financial Report

Attached. The August 2022 financial report was presented. No discussion. A motion to approve the August 2022 financial report was made by Nancy Dymott and seconded by Donna Thomason. Motion passed unanimously. The September 2022 financial report was presented. No discussion. A motion to approve the September 2022 financial report was made by Nancy Dymott and seconded by Brian Schmidt. Motion passed unanimously.

Director's Progress and Service Report

Attached. Discussion included: (1) Julie advised the board Gary Cole may not be able to attend the next several meetings. (2) Julie Yockey will be out of the office starting November 14, 2022. (3) Received an invoice from Randy Dubry for the HVAC work. \$33,347.71. Brian Schmidt moved to approve the invoice. Julie Anderson seconded. Motion passed unanimously. (4) Randy also provided updated estimates for the HVAC project and Julie will be writing grant applications for financial assistance. 5) Two students have graduated from the Excel High School program.

Council Liaison's Report

Brandi Ensor was available to take questions but there was no discussion.

Committee Reports

Building Committee – Julie reported: 1) HVAC work is proceeding. Most, if not all parts, are ready and being delivered. Randy presented the first invoice for his services (approved earlier) and an updated estimate for the project. (2) Julie presented a quote from MOPERM for \$35,138.00. This represented a 5% increase over last year and an increase in insured value replacement cost from \$8,131,800 to \$10,271.00 (or \$2,139,200 or 26%). Brian Schmidt moved to approve the quote from MOPERM and renew the policy. Nancy Dymott seconded. Motion passed unanimously. (3) Julie presented a quote from Coalition for Cyber Insurance - \$2,648.10, a \$761 increase – and read a supporting statement of justification from Mike Tolle.

The Carthage Public Library Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes – October 2022

Nancy Dymott moved to approve the quote and renew the Cyber insurance policy with Coalition. Brain Schmidt seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Budget Committee – Julie Yockey reported: The 2021-2022 financial year is complete and the budget needs to be amended to match actuals. The final budget was \$905,810 but actual expenses were \$930,350, a difference of \$24,540. Reasons given were mostly timing between cash-basis accounting and accrual-basis year-end reports. Kevin Johnson moved to amend the 2021-2022 budget accordingly. Nancy Dymott seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Director's Progress and Service Report

Julie Yockey, Director

The slogan for the Library at the moment is "We apologize for any inconvenience we may cause you." An old standby for us through all of our maintenance issues, and we hope this "Inconvenience" is short lived. The progress on the renovation of our HVAC system is moving along as quickly as it can. All parties involved have been working extra hard to get us back up and running as quickly as possible. Without any heat or air as well as the heavy traffic from all of the machinery involved with this project, the library is on its second week of being closed. The health and safety of our patrons is of the upmost importance to our Library Board. An update will be given at tonight's meeting on the progress that has been made to date.

There are two large newsworthy items to share tonight. One being the Secretary of State's new proposed "Rule" for public libraries. A very controversial situation for all public libraries in our state and a detailed explanation will be given during our meeting. The second item, a huge kudo for our Library as we have received an "Exemplary" status from the Institute of Museum and Library Services. The mission of IMLS is to advance, support, and empower America's museums, libraries, and related organizations through grantmaking, research, and policy development. The agency's four strategic goals are to Champion Lifelong Learning, Strengthen Community Engagement, Advance Collections Stewardship and Access, and Demonstrate Excellence in Public Service. The Institute of Museum and Library Services is the primary source of federal support for the nation's libraries and museums. IMLS envisions a nation where individuals and communities have access to museums and libraries to learn from and be inspired by the trusted information, ideas, and stories they contain about our diverse natural and cultural heritage. During 2022 IMLS funded three million dollars in grant money to the State of Missouri, and our adult citizenship and education program will be featured on their website as an "Exemplary" project! "Your Path to Citizenship@ Your Carthage Public Library" has helped to naturalize over 50 adults in a 6 year period, and has helped to teach numerous others to read and speak in English.

Two new employees have been hired and will start their initial training as soon as the library reopens. We have been working through numerous staff members' sick leave absences which have been very hard to cover as well as losing a staff member to a full time position elsewhere.

We hope to have good news on the library's renovation at this Board meeting, thank you for your patience.
