1. Run Through the Lights - Chanti Beckham

Chanti Beckham spoke with the committee on the 2022 Run Through the Lights. The runners will be running through the CRM on Thursday December 15th from around 6:15pm to 7:30pm. Runners will start at the Church of Nazarene just to the south of the lights (CRM), cross the street and run through the lights display. Some runners will continue onto the Square and back, making it a 5K run. Beckham is requesting to close Fairview traffic from Wynwood to Grand at 6:00pm. ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance to amend Section 23-172(d) of the Code of the City of Carthage to add Hazel Avenue from HH Highway to the North Side of the George Phelps intersection, as a truck route in the City of Carthage, Missouri.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF CARTHAGE, JASPER COUNTY, MISSOURI as follows:

SECTION I: Section 23-172(d) of the Code of the City of Carthage is hereby amended by adding the following phrase:

Hazel Avenue from HH Highway to the North side of the intersection of Hazel Ave and George E. Phelps Ave.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
