Let this letter and accompanying map serve as a formal request from the Carthage Chamber of Commerce in partnership with the City of Carthage and the Parks & Rec. Department as permission to hold the annual July 4th Red, White & Boom community celebration at Municipal Park.

Meetings were held with the Carthage Police & Fire Departments to plan and execute parking closures, street closures, and services needed. Carthage Parks & Rec. has agreed to aid throughout the day and has gone over the layout of Municipal Park.

1. Red, White, Boom July 4th will start at 2 pm until fireworks at 9:30 pm.
2. The stage will be brought out and set up on the 3rd in the designated area so as not to impede the pool gate for emergencies.
3. Carthage Water & Electric will have electric panels secured by June 30th in the correct designated area.
4. We will have 12 food vendors to align the large parking area and will begin serving at 2 pm.
5. Other vendors will be on the outline of the grass area East of the pool, including the Watermelon Feed.
6. Music will begin at 4 pm with a Karaoke Party!
7. KSN will host Living Well Live beginning at 4 pm.
8. A live band will begin at 7 pm and play until the fireworks.
9. Bounce houses, gelly ball arenas, foam machines, cornhole, face painting, outdoor games, and much more will be happening at the park all day.
10. Fair Acres YMCA will host a FREE community swim from 12-8 pm.
11. Kiwanis will have Kiddieland open FREE to the public from 2 -7 pm.
12. Clean up and get out of the park by 11 pm.

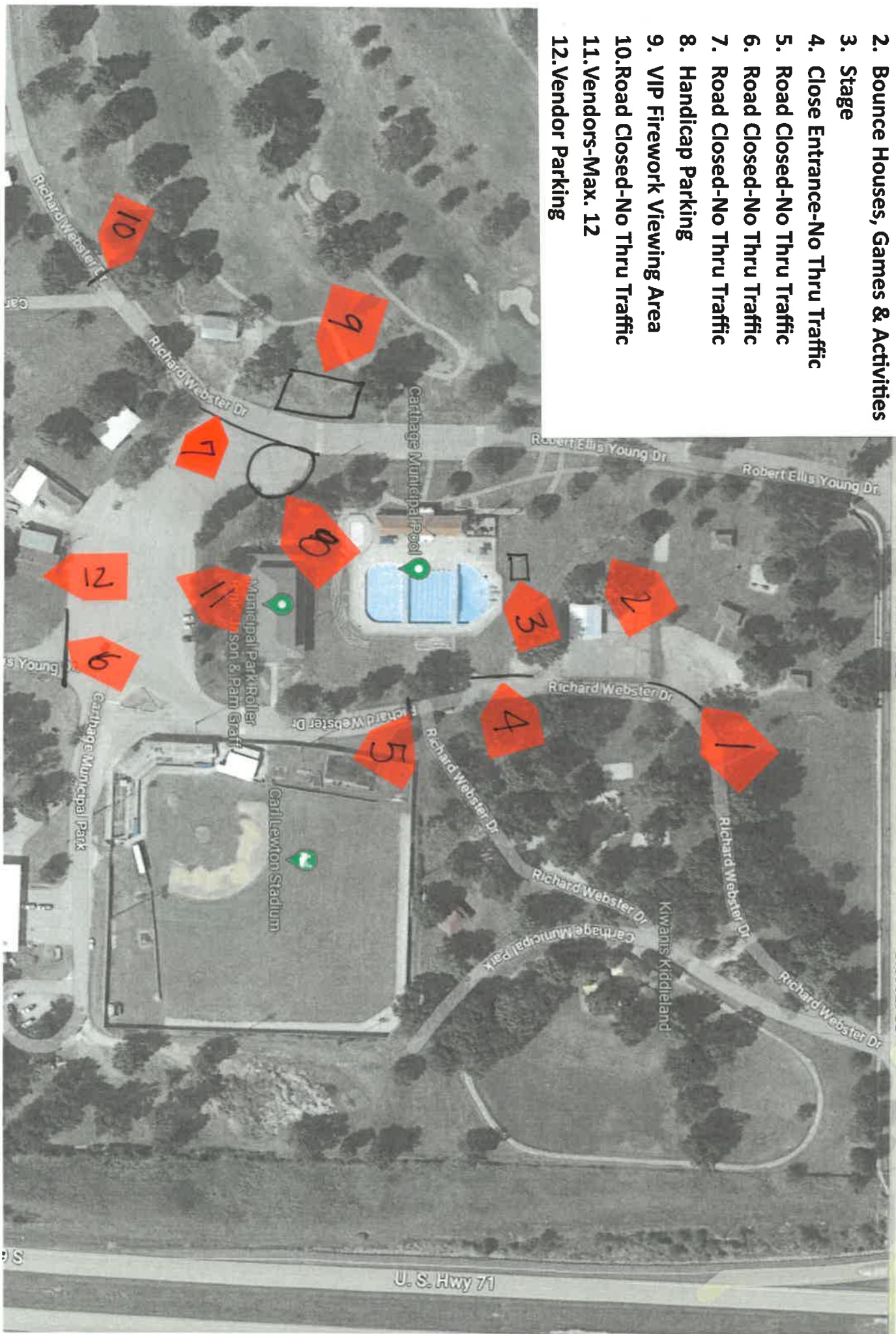

Jasper County Youth Fair

July 8 – July 16, 2023

We are politely requesting from the Public Safety Committee to have our annual **Jasper County Youth Fair July 8- July 16 at Carthage Municipal Park.**

The fair begins on July 8th and ends with clean-up day on Sunday, July 16. Immediately after the fair, the hog barn renovation project will start with a completion date of December 1, 2023.

History – the fair is always the week following the 4th of July each year. We book the date with the Parks and Recreation Department each fall for the following year.

Special request: The **Parks and Recreation Department** hangs the shade clothes for us immediately following the 4th of July fireworks event. They take them down the Monday after the fair.

Road closure request: On Wednesday, July 12, we can close the gates on each end of the fence so that livestock can't escape onto the golf course or onto streets. This eliminates the thru traffic from Wednesday – Saturday night but is accessible in case of an emergency.

Also, the street between the Kolpin Concession Stand and the north pavilion, we close off to thru traffic so people can safely walk to visit our vendors. We have a small number of food trucks, craft vendors, livestock show supply vendor.

Tent: We also request permission to put up a tent on the east side of the Chitwood barn for our kids games and BBQ Market Sale Meal.

During the fair, we clean the restrooms and supply all paper goods to take the burden off the Parks Department. We dump our own trash barrels and bring in our own dumpsters for trash. We take care of the animal waste and clean up the fairgrounds before we leave.
